National High Performance Director (NHPD)

The Indian Golf Union (IGU), the National Sports Federation for Golf in India, invites applications for the position of **National High Performance Director (NHPD)** to lead and implement its High Performance Programme for elite golfers.

The NHPD will be responsible for planning, managing, and monitoring the overall high-performance pathway for Indian golfers, with the objective of enhancing performances at major international championships, including the **Olympics Games, Asian Games, Commonwealth Games, World Amateur Team Championships and other tournaments.**

Key Responsibilities

- Develop and implement the IGU High Performance Strategy and annual performance plans.
- Manage the National Squads (Men, Women, Junior Boys, and Junior Girls).
- Plan and coordinate National Coaching Camps and overseas training programmes.
- Monitor athlete performance through data analysis, performance reviews, and competition results.
- Coordinate with National Coaches, sports science experts, physiotherapists, nutritionists, psychologists, and strength & conditioning coaches.
- Prepare proposals for Government funding, including SAI and TOPS programmes.
- Plan international exposure tours and competition schedules.
- Liaise with stakeholders including SAI, MYAS, IOA, APGC, The R&A, IGF, and State Golf Associations.
- Develop athlete pathways from junior to elite level and oversee talent identification initiatives.
- Prepare periodic performance reports and monitor the utilisation of grants and programme budgets.

Essential Qualifications & Experience

- Bachelor's Degree in any discipline.
- A minimum of **3 years of experience** as a Category A NGAI Teaching Professional
- Experience working with elite athletes, national squads, or high-performance programmes.
- Knowledge of golf, athlete development pathways, and international competition structures will be preferred.

Skills

- Strong leadership and organisational skills.
- Excellent planning, project management, and communication abilities.
- Experience in performance analysis, budgeting, and stakeholder management.
- Ability to work collaboratively with coaches, athletes, government agencies, and international federations.
